RETREAT RULES

1. BE RESPECTFUL

- Do not, <u>under any circumstances</u>, enter the housing areas of the opposite gender. You will be sent home.
- Treat others the way you want to be treated. Listen to camp staff and adult leaders. No vandalism of camp property.
- All students must be in their cabin by 11:30pm and quiet at lights out time (12:00am).
- No food is allowed in your cabin unless given special permission for medical reasons.

2. BE WHERE YOU'RE SUPPOSED TO BE

- Main sessions, organized activities, small groups, meals, and showers are MANDATORY.
- Follow the schedule and be where you are supposed to be. During blocks of free time, when you have a choice of activity, you must be present in one of the designated areas or your cabin.
- No attendees may enter undesignated buildings or camp areas. The only buildings in use during the retreat are the Orchard Terrace (cabins), Rec Center, Calvary Chapel and Dining Hall.

3. NAMETAG

- Always wear your nametag to all main sessions, organized activities, small groups and meals.

4. BETTER TOGETHER

- Always stay in groups of 2 or more and always be sure to ask a leader for permission before going anywhere.
- Your cabin leaders are your chaperones your go-to in case of an emergency.
- Your assigned cabin is your assigned small group. You will be together all weekend for designated small groups. Make sure to follow your group leaders' instructions. Groups can split up during free time, seminars, organized activities and meals.

5. PHONE & AIRPODS POLICY

- Phones and AirPods are only allowed during times on the schedule where there is a (+) symbol.
- Absolutely no viewing/sending anything inappropriate. You will be sent home immediately.
- Lights out = screens off.
- Your phone will be placed in the "Sad Emoji" box until the retreat is over if you can't follow these rules.

6. NO PUBLIC (OR PRIVATE) DISPLAYS OF AFFECTION

- No "purple", "dark blue", or "dark pink".
- Examples include: kissing, hugging, holding hands, cuddling, etc.

7. DRESS CODE

- Shorts at fingertip length.
- No cut-off shirts, low-cut shirts, also no stomachs or sports bras showing.

8. CONTRABAND

- Any student found with possession of alcohol, tobacco, drugs, and/or weapons will be sent home.
- Examples include: vapes, e-cigarettes, juuls, pocket knives, any blades, lighters, guns, etc.
