

CAMPING RULES

1. BE RESPECTFUL

- Do not, under any circumstances, enter the tents and/or bathrooms of the opposite gender. You will be sent home.
- Treat others the way you want to be treated. Listen to ALIVE staff and adult leaders.
- No vandalism of camp property.

2. BE WHERE YOU'RE SUPPOSED TO BE

- Morning and evening speaking sessions, evening concerts, meals, and showers are MANDATORY.
- Follow the schedule and be where you are supposed to be when you're supposed to be there.
- All students must be at our campsite by 11:00 pm and quiet at lights out time (12:00am).

3. BETTER TOGETHER

- Always stay in groups of 3 or more and always be sure to ask an adult leader for permission before going anywhere.
- Adult leaders are your go-to in case of an emergency.
- Stay in your assigned tent for the duration of the event.

4. PHONE & AIRPODS POLICY

- Phones and AirPods are allowed.
- No phones and/or AirPods are allowed during speaking sessions.
- Absolutely no viewing/sending anything inappropriate. You will be sent home immediately.
- Students will be given one verbal warning.
- Your phone will be placed in the "Sad Emoji" box until ALIVE is over if you can't follow these rules.

5. NO PUBLIC (OR PRIVATE) DISPLAYS OF AFFECTION

- No "purple", "dark blue", or "dark pink".
- Examples include: kissing, hugging, holding hands, cuddling, etc.

6. DRESS CODE

- Shorts at fingertip length.
- No low-cut shirts, also no stomachs or sports bras showing.
- Permitted swimwear includes the following: one-piece, a t-shirt worn over a bikini, and swim trunks

7. CONTRABAND

- Any student found with possession of alcohol, tobacco, drugs, and/or weapons will be sent home.
- Examples include: vapes, e-cigarettes, juuls, pocket knives, any blades, lighters, guns, etc.
