

# Cedar Point

**Who:** All students in grades 6-12

**What:** Our annual trip to Cedar Point, the Roller Coaster Capital of the World.

**When:** Friday, July 26<sup>th</sup> (We leave from Murrysville Alliance Church at 6:00 AM.)

**Where:** Sandusky, Ohio (roughly 3 hours away)

Here are some things to remember...

- The cost includes transportation, ticket, and an all-day drink wristband.
- **A 2024 medical release form must be on church file and a parental consent form completed in order to go.**
- Please drop your student(s) off at the church no later than 5:45 AM.
- The plan is to spend the entire day at the park (open to close). Then we will make the trip home and arrive back at the church around 4:00 AM for pick-up.
- Bring some money for both lunch and dinner in the park and other snacks. There are various places to eat at Cedar Point.
- Cedar Point is cashless. This means that ONLY credit and debit cards are acceptable forms of payment in the park. There are cash-to-card kiosks in the park that will allow your student to transfer cash into a prepaid card. These prepaid cards can be used throughout the entire park and outside the park. I assume visa prepaid cards, bought before the trip, will work too.
- We are not stopping for breakfast. Please have your student eat before getting to the church or bring something with them to eat on the way.
- Please wear comfortable walking shoes and bring sunscreen.
- Students can bring backpacks to hold their belongings. You can leave them in a locked vehicle while in the park. I highly encourage taking as little as possible into the park. Each student is responsible for their own belongings.
- All bags, purses, backpacks, waist packs, etc. will be examined prior to entering.
- Loose article policies vary for park rides. Visit the Ride Policies and Procedures page on the Cedar Point website for more information. Note that Valravn, GateKeeper, Rougarou, Magnum XL-200, Steel Vengeance and Millennium Force riders are required to store their belongings (purses, prizes, video cameras, etc.) in the secure lockers at various ride's entrance's as they are not permitted in line or on the rides.
- Moveable lockers are available at ride locations. Rent a locker that can move from location to location for one price.
- Drink plenty of water. We do not want anyone getting dehydrated.
- Communicate. Communicate. Communicate. Our time will go smoothly if there is clear communication. If your student is hurt, sick and/or needs something, please have them talk to Pastor Alec or an adult leader.

Rules:

- All students must remain in groups of 4 or more at all times unless given special permission by Pastor Alec or another adult volunteer.
- Be respectful of others in and outside our group.
- Listen and be respectful of all adult volunteers.
- No clothing with profane images and/or words.
