INDIANAPOLIS, IN – JULY 4-9, 2025

COST/REGISTRATION

Total Cost = \$1,100

- Conference = \$489 per person (Register by Oct. 27)
 - All main sessions – worship, speakers, and special guests.
 - Access to your choice of 50+ seminars throughout the week.
 - Service Project transportation, lunch, and supplies
 - Access to all Activity Halls
 - The Prayer, Justice, and Missions Experience
 - 8 meals (Lunch and Dinner)
- Hotel Room = \$205 per person for 5 nights (4 or 5 students per room)
- Transportation = \$245 per person
 - Rental Vans
 - Gas Expense
 - Parking
- Food = \$80 (food for 6 days)
- ZipZone Outdoor Adventures (Columbus, OH) = \$85

Registration is open through Sunday, October 27th.

- A \$150 non-refundable deposit is required at the time of registration.

MAIN SESSIONS

- All students are required to sit together and be at every main session (1 morning and 1 evening).

SEMINARS/EXPERIENCES

- All students are required to go to 1 breakout session each day (morning or afternoon). There are various seminars to choose from. Each student can pick which seminar he/she would like to attend.

- Participate in one Prayer, Justice, or Missions experience as a group.

FOOD

- Lunch and dinner will be provided by the conference, starting at Lunch on Saturday, July 5th. Please bring money for lunch on our travel day to Indianapolis, IN.
- The only meal we are responsible for during the conference is breakfast. I have included the cost for breakfast in the total cost for our trip to take care of that for each student attending. Breakfast food will be bought in bulk and distributed among the group.
- Additionally, the cost for dinner on July 4th and lunch on July 9th has been included in the total cost.

5K RUN

- THIS IS OPTIONAL. The cost of the 5K is \$45. You can note in your registration form if your student wants to participate in this event. This will be an additional \$45 on top of the total cost for LIFE. At the time of registration, you will be required to pay both the non-refundable deposit and the 5K registration cost.

HOTEL/CONVENTION CENTER

- If our hotel **is** attached to the convention center, then students have the freedom to go back and forth from their rooms and the convention center without an adult leader. Students must notify an adult leader of their whereabouts.
- If our hotel **is not** attached to the convention center, then students must be accompanied by an adult leader when traveling back and forth from their rooms and the convention center.
- Students must gain permission and be accompanied by an adult leader if they desire to travel outside the hotel/convention center for any reason. In the event that a student does not follow this rule, the student will be sent home at the cost of him/her and the parents.
- For no reason at all, should anyone of one gender be in the opposite gender's room. In the event that were to occur, the student will be sent home at the cost of him/her and the parents.
- Students must fully shower at least once a day.

EMERGENCIES

- In case of an emergency (sickness, accident, and etc.), the student will be accompanied by an adult leader and parents will be notified. Proper steps will be taken according to the needs of the student.

TRANSPORTATION

- 15-passenger vans
- It's roughly a 6 hour trip one-way.

OTHER GUIDELINES

1. Be Respectful
 - Treat others the way you want to be treated. Listen to both LIFE workers and adult leaders.
 - No vandalism of hotel/convention center property.
 - Adhere to quiet hours.
2. Be where you're supposed to be when you're supposed to be there.
3. Always wear your nametag and/or LIFE bracelet.
 - Are needed for all things LIFE conference.
4. Better Together
 - Students must always be in groups of at least 3, unless given permission to do otherwise.
5. Phone & Airpods Policy
 - No phones are allowed when the speaker is on stage unless prompted by the speaker. Bring a physical Bible. If you don't have a physical Bible, see Pastor Alec.
 - Students are encouraged to have fun and take pictures and/or videos.
 - Absolutely no viewing/sending anything inappropriate. You will be sent home immediately
 - Your phone will be placed in the "Sad Emoji" box until the conference is over if you can't follow these rules.
6. No public displays of affection.
 - Examples include but are not limited to: kissing, hugging, holding hands, cuddling, and etc.
7. Dress Code
 - Shorts at fingertip length.
 - Low-cut shirts and any clothing that reveals your stomachs and/or sports bras are not permitted.
 - One-piece swimsuits or bikini with a t-shirt worn over are acceptable. Speedos are not permitted.
8. Contraband
 - Any student found with possession of alcohol, tobacco, drugs, and/or weapons will be sent home at the expense of him/her and the parents.
 - Examples include but are not limited to: vapes, e-cigarettes, juuls, pocket knives, any blades, lighters, guns, and etc.

 - Day 10: Ask 2 teachers or coaches for \$20 each

If your student raises above the cost of LIFE, then the exceeding amount will go into the general account to help any other students attending LIFE.

If LIFE is cancelled for any reason, all money earned through fundraisers will be used for another Harbor Youth mission trip/event.
